Choral Services resume on Monday April 15th

The **Diocese of Leeds Schools Singing Programme** is recognised as the UK's leading choral education programme, striving to make outstanding singing tuition, music education and performance opportunities accessible to children and young people in communities which are least likely to encounter them. The programme reaches over 6,500 children each week, both during and outside the school day in over 150 choral groups, including boys' and girls' choirs in Bradford, Harrogate, Huddersfield, Keighley, Pontefract, Ripon and Wakefield, together with the six choirs of Leeds Cathedral.

The **Leeds Cathedral Choirs** draw their membership from the weekly Schools Singing Programme sessions within inner-city state schools. Acknowledged as among the finest in the country, the choirs sing at eight services in the Cathedral each week, and their recordings of choral works by Maurice Duruflé and Arvo Pärt for Brilliant Classics are critically-acclaimed. The Cathedral Choirs broadcast regularly on BBC radio and television, and will sing Choral Vespers on Radio 3 on 31 January 2023.

The **Keyboard Studies Programme** was launched in May 2016 to provide high-quality organ and piano tuition across the Diocese to children and adults alike. With a national decline in students learning the organ, the Programme reintroduces this instrument steeped in tradition to students of all backgrounds, teaching them valuable musical skills and opening doors to opportunities in further education and choral direction. Through lessons on the organ, piano, classical accordion and whole-class melodica sessions, the programme now engages over 1,500 children each week.
